Pwani University TVET offers CDACC programs accredited by the Technical and Vocational Education and Training Authority (TVETA). This Competency Based Education and Training (CBET) system expects trainees to possess and wear requisite work & protective equipment (PPEs). Here are specific PPES for each program:

<b>Department</b>	<b>Specifications</b>
<b>Agricultural Sciences</b>	<b>General Agriculture &amp; Crop Sciences:</b> All trainees shall bring blue overalls; black gum boots, a jembe with handle and a panga
	<b>Dairy Farm &amp; Animal Health Management:</b> Shall bring white gumboots, white laboratory coat, a hoof trimming knife and a Weight band.
	<b>All Engineering programs:</b> Blue overalls, industrial boots and eye protective gear
<b>Applied Sciences</b>	<b>ICT, Computer Sciences and Data Management:</b> All trainees shall bring a Laptop with minimum processor specs of <b>Core i5</b> . In addition, they shall bring blue dust coats, and an ICT repair tool kit (TK10 13-Zip Pouch) and Eye protective gear.
	<b>Applied Biology   Medical Laboratory:</b> shall bring white laboratory coat and eye protective gear
<b>Health Sciences</b>	<b>All Health Sciences:</b> All trainees shall bring a white laboratory coat and scrubs, a training caliber stethoscope and low-heeled closed shoes
<b>Business studies</b>	<b>Tourism Management:</b> Shall bring navy blue blazer/waist coat (sleeveless blazer), white long-sleeved shirt  blouse, and navy blue trouser  skirt with a marron scarf for ladies or marron bow-tie for men
